TRAIL RIDE GUIDELINES UPDATE

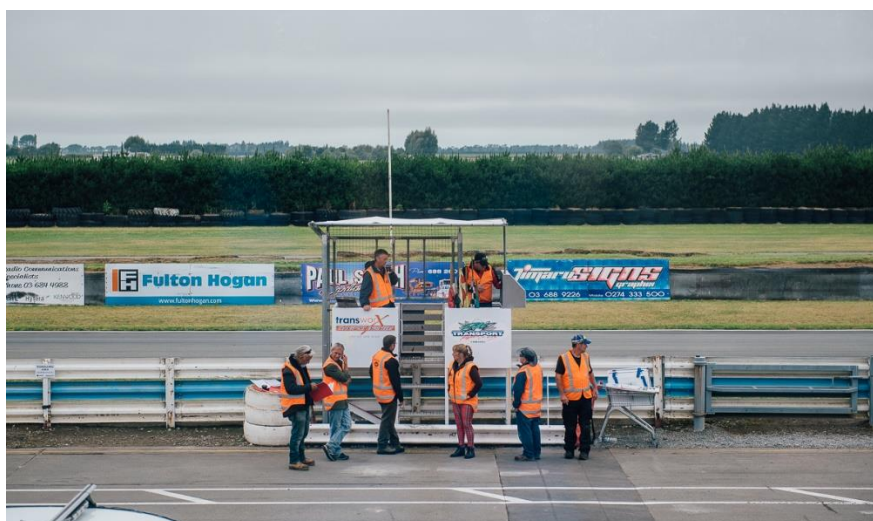
