Our goal is to support and grow your club coaches through this programme which will help deliver consistent coaching across the country. Unfortunately Niki Urwin is unavailable for the balance of the year, however we will be putting in place more coaching sessions with Niki in the New Year. We would love to see some of your club coaches come along to this training. Motorcycling New Zealand will then be introducing a coaching pathway programme for Off Road and Road in 2020 with a clear plan to grow our sport with some “back to basics” training for grass roots to a High Performance Academy programme.



### TRAIL RIDES

Last month Nick Reader completed another audit which delivered some very positive results and a great opportunity for us to support the club. Based on club feedback after this year's audits we will be making some amendments to the draft guidelines and will send these out as a draft next month along with some printed material we have developed to support the delivery of Trail rides. Nick will continue in the New Year to audit trail rides and provide some support and guidance to ensure we are keeping our riders, clubs and officials as safe as practicably possible.

Great to see so many clubs looking at ways in which to grow their members and as a result we have 432 new licenced members from the start of this year's licencing season.
