## RULE CHANGES 2020-2021

The 2020-2021 version of the Manual of Motorcycle Sport came into effect on the 1st August 2020.

Updated rules can now be found on the MNZ website and the MNZ App.

To update the MoMS in the MNZ App please follow the below steps while you have an internet connection:

1. Open the MNZ App
2. Click on the "MORE" tab at the bottom of the screen, this will take you to the settings screen.
3. Click on the MANUAL OF MOTORCYCLE SPORT
4. You will now see at the top, a black bar reading UPDATE RULES – Please click on this to update the MoMS in your App.

Rule change proposals can be submitted each year, between 1<sup>st</sup> August and 28<sup>th</sup> February. Rule changes can only be submitted by a club or the relevant discipline commissioner.

Special thanks to our Rules Appraisal Committee, Clubs & Commissioners for their invaluable support implement the new rule changes.

## THE RESTRICTED RIDERS LIST

- You can print the latest version for your weekend's event after 5pm on Friday from the MNZ website
- Or you can access the list from the MNZ App on your phone – found in the MORE tab
- Remember to sync your phone at home before leaving for every event while you have an internet connection. Do this by clicking on the MORE tab in the App and then clicking on the SYNC button.

## EVENT INJURY REPORT

The MNZ office have been receiving a number of injury reports with very little information about the rider and the type of injury, which means riders cannot be contacted to advise them they require a medical clearance before riding at their next event.

- Could you ensure your medics supply the full details of each injury and the riders name is correct when completing the Event Injury Report
- If you had injuries at your event please let the MNZ office know on Monday
- If you held onto any licences/logbooks these must be sent to the MNZ office on Monday following the event
