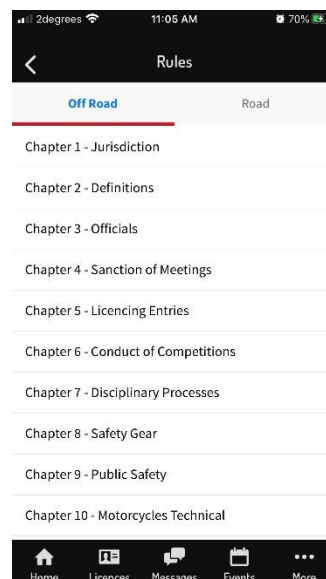
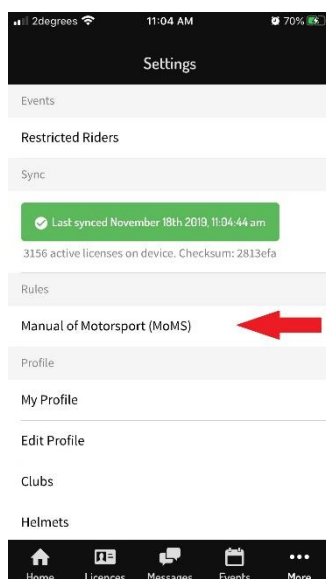

MoMS IN THE MNZ APP

Please remember that a full set of the MoMS is available for view in the MNZ App in your Settings tab. Each chapter can be opened in a new webpage and read individually with a search function. No need to panic if you have forgotten to take your black folder.

STEWARDS & COC REPORTS

Please can you ensure these are sent into the MNZ office within 7 days following the event – this includes the Event Injury Form. These can be emailed through to Angela at admin@mnz.co.nz or completed through the MNZ App.

Any injured riders need to be placed on the Restricted Riders List as soon as possible after injury has occurred, meaning licences/logbooks of injured riders need to be sent into the office on the Monday following the event.

Save Angela some time by getting these into her in a timely manner so she doesn't have to follow up with you later!

COMPLETING AN OEL

Can we please ensure OEL information is completed accurately i.e. date of event and permit number are always filled in. Our goal remains to get these forms onto the MNZ App and processed online, however we are not quite there yet.

We are now supplying 25 New Member/Welcome Back Licence forms with all One Event Licence book's sent out to the clubs. These are stapled together with a note outlining our OEL discount and can easily be placed on your registration table at events for riders purchasing an OEL or wanting to join up.

TRAIL RIDE GUIDELINES UPDATE

We are in the process of finalising the draft Trail Ride Guidelines, a huge thanks to Craig Mills and Nick Reader for their support. We will have the document on the website for you all to review by the end of the month. Nick will continue to undertake audits for MNZ over the next 12 months and work with our clubs to ensure consistent safety guidelines are met for all our members.

DRUG TESTING

Recently we conducted a random drug testing at the Greymouth Street Race event. We are very happy with the professionalism and discretion in which this process was handled. It went really smoothly with our Officials and the testing agency working well together. MNZ will continue to carry out random drug testing at events to ensure riders compete in a safe and fair manner.
